

Leeds Bus Review Consultation and Tender Outcomes to be introduced 20/21 July 2013

Inner North East Leeds Areas **(Moortown, Oakwood, Potternewton, Roundhay)**

Main Impacts

The ring road service 8 will no longer operate on Saturdays due to poor levels of use.

The evening operation of service 38 (White Rose Centre – Kirkstall – Headingley – Moortown Corner – Gledhow) will be withdrawn due to low passenger use.

- **Service 7A (Leeds – Scott Hall Road – Moortown – Alwoodley)**

The following poorly used journey will be withdrawn:-

2305 (Daily) Alwoodley – Leeds Wellington Street

This service will continue to be operated by First Leeds.

- **Service 7S (Leeds – Scott Hall Road – Moortown – Alwoodley)**

The following poorly used journey will be withdrawn:-

2336 (Daily) Shadwell – Potternewton Lane

This service will continue to be operated by First Leeds.

- **Service 8 (Pudsey – Horsforth – Moortown – Seacroft)**

The Saturday service will be withdrawn due to low passenger use.

A small number of Monday to Friday peak journeys will be extended from Seacroft to Thorpe Park via Cross Gates.

The following journeys will be withdrawn due to low use:-

0611 (Mon – Fri) Pudsey – Seacroft

0555 (Mon – Fri) Seacroft - Pudsey

0645 (Mon – Fri) Seacroft - Pudsey

Most journeys will now terminate at Horsforth and will not continue to Pudsey. A few journeys during the peak period will operate to or from Pudsey.

Buses terminating at Horsforth will now operate into Horsforth via Broadway (Ring Road) but will operate from Horsforth towards Seacroft via the present route.

The timetable has been revised to provide connections with Service 9 at Horsforth for through passengers.

During the daytime period, Service 8 will be extended to Halton via the proposed Service 60 route. The additional journeys to Thorpe Park will operate as Service 8A and the timetable has been revised.

This service will be operated by Harrogate Coach Travel.

- **Service 38 (White Rose Centre – Wortley – Kirkstall – Headingley – Moortown Corner – Gledhow)**

Due to very low passenger use, the evening service will be withdrawn. There will be no service after 1900 Monday - Friday and after 1800 on Saturdays and Sundays.

The following early morning journeys will be withdrawn:-

0546 (Mon - Fri) Kirkstall - Wortley Ringways

0625 (Mon - Fri) Moortown Corner - Wortley Ringways

0627 (Sat) Wortley Ringways - Gledhow

0727 (Sat) Wortley Ringways - Gledhow

0720 (Sat) Gledhow - Wortley Ringways

Centrebus will continue to operate the peak period service during the week.

First Leeds will operate the midday and Sunday services.

- **Service 781 (Leeds – Harewood – Weardley – Otley)**

There will be no change to this service. It will continue to operate as at present for a year and will be reviewed again in July 2014.
